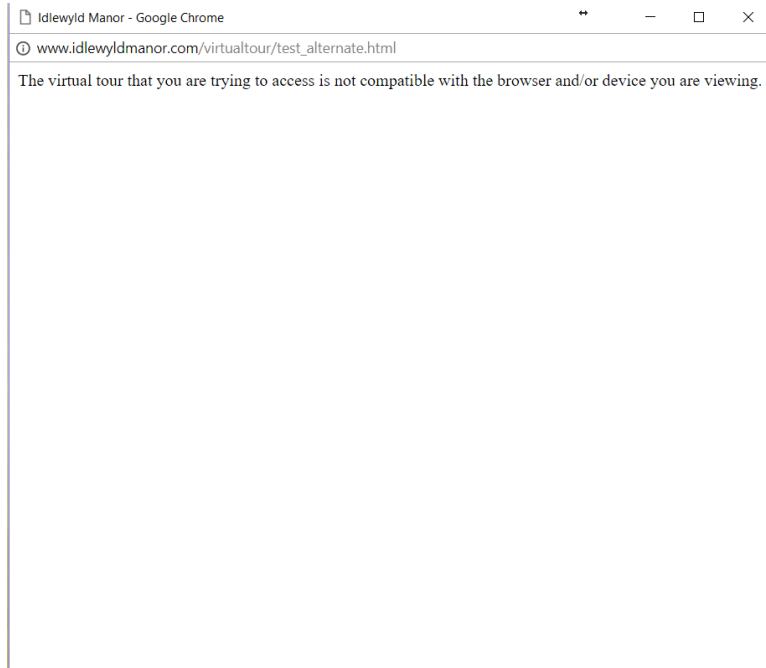
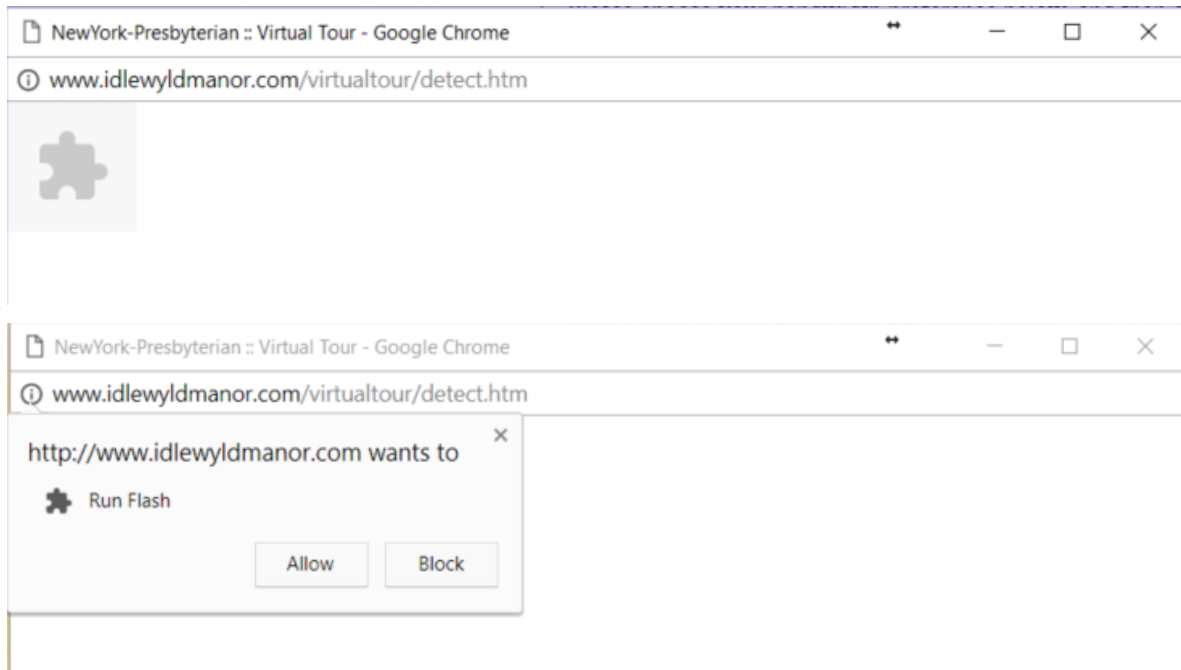


## Enabling Flash on Web Browsers for Idlewyld Virtual Tour:

When you select Virtual Tour, you may see a page like below:

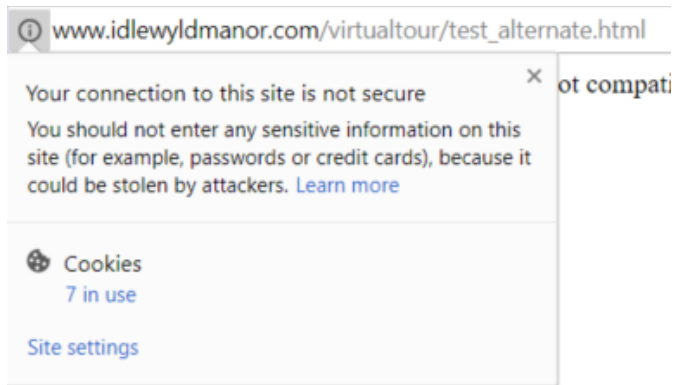


This means that Flash is not enabled in your web browser. If you are quick, you may see a little puzzle piece appear on this page before the text. If you click on the little puzzle piece it will ask if you would like to allow or deny flash being enabled. If the puzzle piece does not appear; follow the below steps pertaining to the web browser you are trying to use to enable Flash.

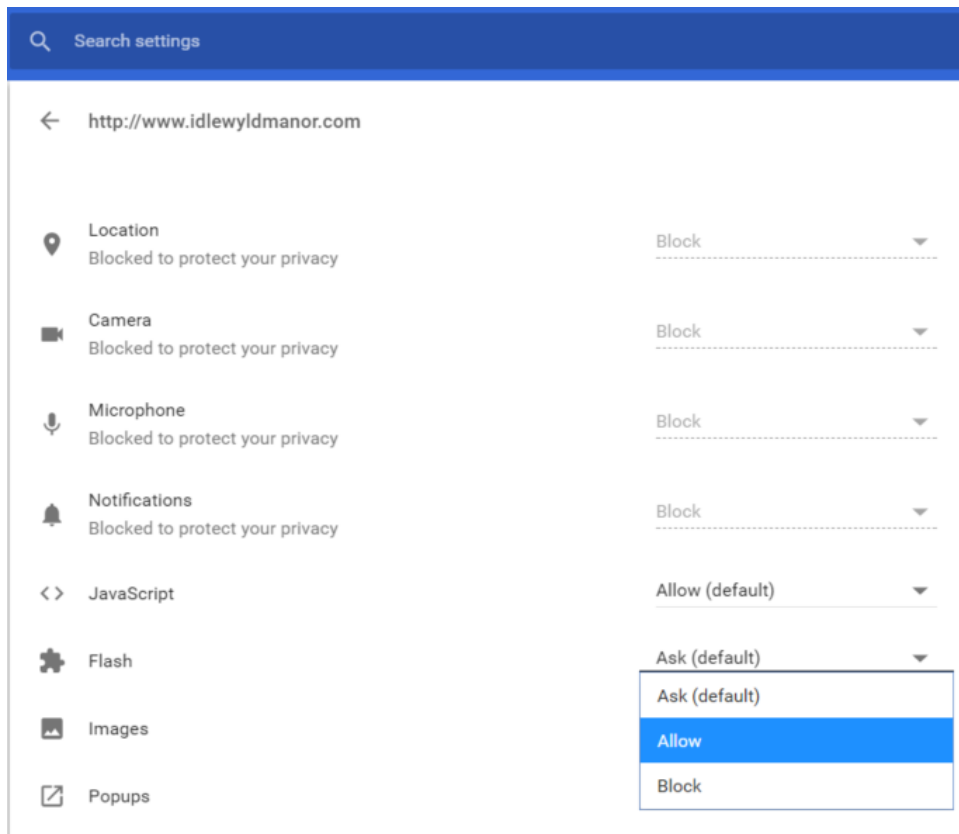


## CHROME


Click the  button beside the URL ([www.idlewyldmanor.com](http://www.idlewyldmanor.com) as seen above in image). From the drop down that shows up after clicking the icon, select 'Site Settings'.

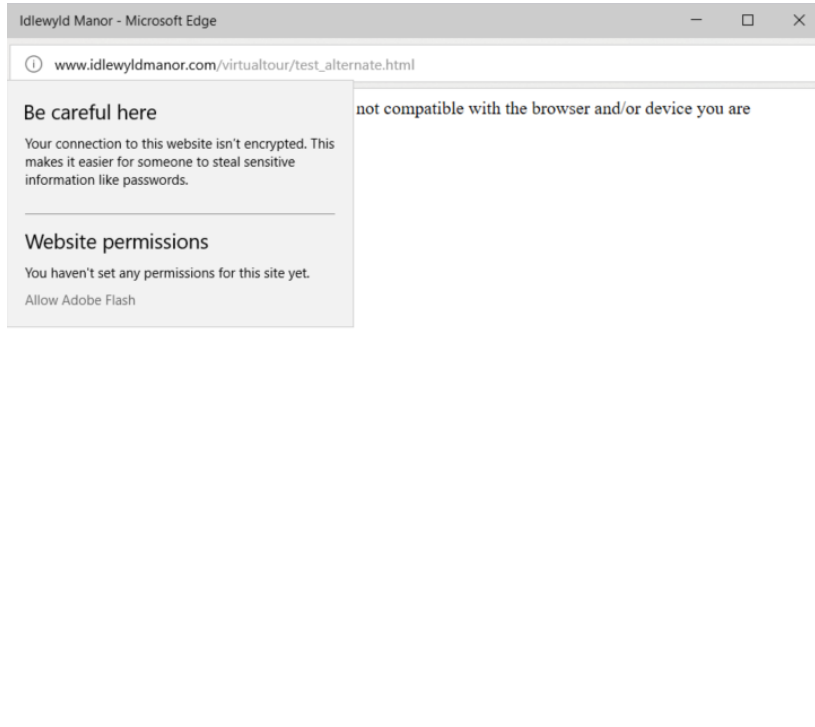


Scroll down to Flash and change the option from 'Ask (Default)' to 'Allow'.



## Microsoft Edge

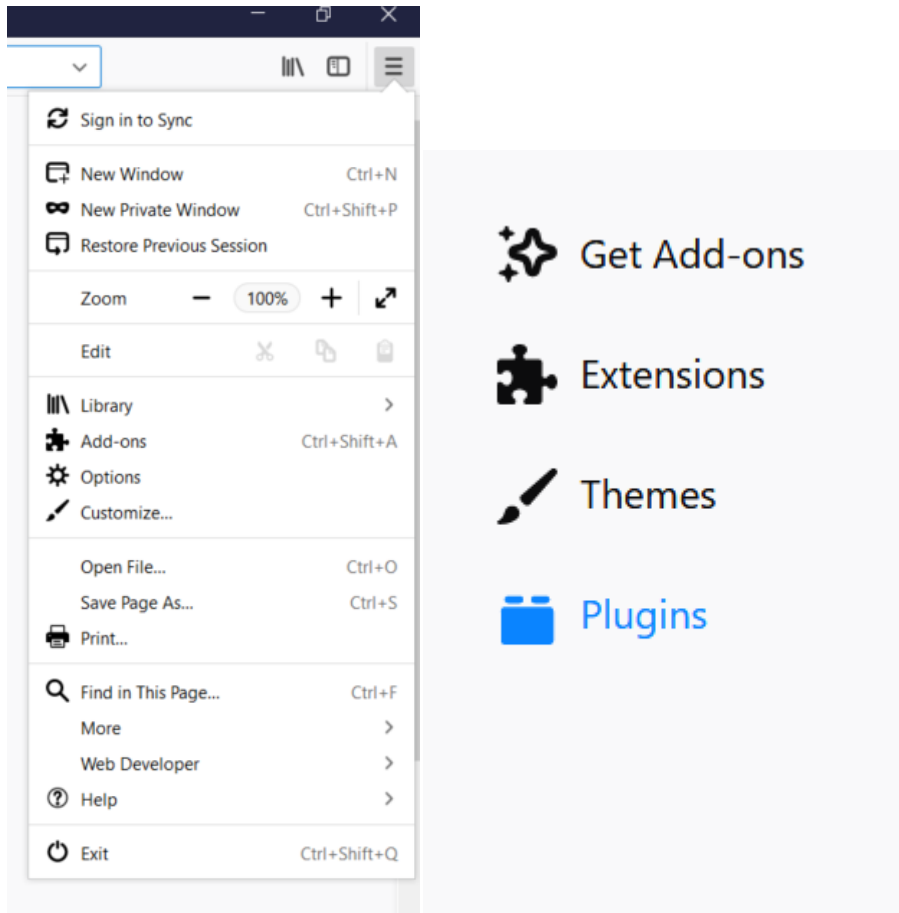
Click the  button beside the URL ([www.idlewyldmanor.com](http://www.idlewyldmanor.com) as seen above in image). From the drop down that shows up after clicking the icon, select 'Allow Adobe Flash'. Then just close and reopen the virtual tour.



## Firefox

It is not recommended you use Firefox for websites that require flash. Flash does not work very well with firefox and there is no good way to integrate flash player into Firefox especially on Windows 10.

To enable it (will not always work), select menu as shown below and click 'Add-Ons'. Once this page opens up, select 'Plugins' from the list on the left.



This will now open a list of available plugins for firefox. Search the list for 'Shockwave Flash' or 'Adobe Flash'. To enable, simply change it to Allow. If neither of these is here, you will have to view the web page on a different browser.
